


Real Madrid has their main pitch on Santiago Bernabeu Stadium, 11 football pitches and two pitches under construction on the Real Madrid City training facility, all of which will be maintained by Toro® products. The new agreement gives Real Madrid access to new Toro products and technologies, as well as an extensive training program for operators.

The Club's current irrigation system includes Toro® TS90 and INFINITY® Series sprinkler heads and Toro Network VP Satellite field controllers, as well as Turf Guard® sensors, which track soil moisture, salinity and temperature data to help grounds crews irrigate efficiently. The Club also manages irrigation schedules with Toro's Lynx® central control system, which combines all essential irrigation information in a single interface.

In addition to Toro irrigation products, Real Madrid uses Toro Reelmaster® 3100 large-area reel mowers, Workman® MDE and MDX utility vehicles, ProCore® 648 aerators and Multi Pro® 1750 dedicated spray application vehicles. Real Madrid's grounds depend on Toro equipment. Their pitches get a lot of wear and tear from players on the turf, so they need to be aerated often with the ProCore 648. It keeps the surface softer, which is important for the players' safety, and it also helps with drainage and root growth especially when seeding.

The Reelmaster 3100 reel mowers are necessary to maintain an outstanding quality of cut is outstanding. They are easier to operate, which helps with productivity.

The new stadium, DY Patil Stadium and Navi Mumbai would be within a half hour drive from each other so that fans can watch matches on same day in both the venues.









The long-distance radius and fast rotation of Perrot's sports field sprinklers make them an ideal choice for maintaining both natural and synthetic turf on soccer, tennis, hockey, golf and equine venues across the globe.

"The addition of the Perrot portfolio helps expand Toro's presence in the sports field

and agricultural industries, while also growing our position in adjacencies to our core businesses," said Rick Olson, Toro's president and Chief Executive Officer. The Perrot long range sprinklers provide additional irrigation solutions for the professional turf market. From the impact drive pop-ups to the big guns Perrot sprinklers can cover distances from 12 to 69m, making them ideal for soccer, and polo fields, hockey pitches and racecourses. At its peak the iconic VP3 piston drive pop up sprinkler is capable of reaching a throw of a staggering 54m, meaning it can safely span the entire width of a hockey pitch or soccer field from outside the playing surface. It is also the only long range sprinkler approved by the International Hockey Federation and FIFA.





Toro Multi Pro® sprayers are known for their durability. But as with any machine, they require routine maintenance to make sure you're getting the performance you need and the long service life you want.

This article will cover a general maintenance routine with an emphasis on pump maintenance.

Clean Inside And Out

The chemicals that pass through your sprayer can cause corrosion, create clogs, and damage parts, especially if left in the machine when it's not in use. When you're done spraying for the day, *let "triple rinse" be your motto*. Rinse and spray the tank out completely three times, or until the fluid runs clear. All accessories should be rinsed out as well. This will help keep debris out of the tank and ensure that you don't mix chemicals from different applications. Triple rinse after each use and then let the pump run to be sure the lines are purged and dry.

Cleaning the outside of the sprayer is important, too. Any chemical residue can be a safety hazard for operators and can also lead to corrosion. Use a reliable cleaning product to thoroughly remove dirt and residue from the sprayer.

If you're storing your sprayer for the winter or won't be using it for a week or more, follow the cleaning by adding a pump conditioner or non-toxic RV antifreeze to protects the components. Put two to three gallons (7.5 to 11 liters) of pump conditioner in your sprayer and pump it through the system until it comes out of the nozzles. Then shut down your sprayer and store it with the pump conditioner left inside.

Proper Lubrication

Your sprayer is factory greased with 10.5 oz/300 gm of grease at each lubrication point. Over time, grease breaks down and parts need to be re-lubricated to ensure proper performance. Toro recommends adding 1 oz/30 gm of grease to each lubrication point after every 50 hours of normal operation.

- ✓ Use only lithium-based grease
- ✓ Be sure that your grease gun is calibrated so that you deliver the proper amount of grease
- ✓ Make sure the pump is stopped before lubricating.

If your pump has been disassembled, such as for replacement of the diaphragms and/or check valves, then it must be greased with 7 oz/200 gm of grease at each lubrication point before returning to operation.

Yearly Rebuild


An annual inspection and rebuild goes a long way toward ensuring years of reliable sprayer operation. Under normal operating conditions, take the pump apart once a year to inspect diaphragms and check



valves for wear and cracks. Plan to replace the valves and diaphragm every 450 hours. Your service manual provides complete details, and for your convenience a rebuild kit with everything you need is available through the parts catalog.

Troubleshooting

If you're experiencing operational issues that aren't corrected through the routine maintenance, use this checklist* to help find the cause and solution.

If you had a neighbour with a mintcondition car from the 1970s in his driveway and you asked him how he kept it in such great shape, the first words out of his mouth would probably be "I took care of it." He had to perform maintenance on a regular basis.

It may sound basic, but that's also one of the most important things you can do to help your Toro® equipment last longer.

Manufacturers' recommended maintenance schedules and genuine parts aren't just arbitrary suggestions. They're based on extensive testing of what's required to maintain the integrity of your machine. And these recommended scheduled events need to take place in order to get the best quality out of your unit.

Here are some additional tips to help you get the most out of your equipment investment:

1. Make a list of daily operation checks and use it.

Some maintenance items are based on hours of operation. But your operator's manual will also recommend checking certain things each time you use your machine. Recommendations vary by

model, but examples include checking the engine oil level, hydraulic system, cooling system, etc.

2. Use the proper engine oil classification for your machine.

This may not sound like a big deal, but using the wrong viscosity grade or weight of engine oil can be serious enough to void your warranty.

Don't exceed the specified service interval.

You can always perform regular maintenance sooner than required, but skipping or delaying tasks may shorten the life of your machine. Also beware of products and manufacturers that make claims that conflict with the manufacturer's maintenance schedule. These claims don't always hold up, and cutting corners can lead to costly problems. Choose quality products and follow the timing the manufacturer recommends for your operating conditions.

4. Document everything.

Keep records of the maintenance you've performed and parts you've ordered. This gives you a timeline to keep your maintenance on track and helps answer questions if you need to make a warranty claim. You may be surprised how often owners estimate they changed the engine



oil "a couple months ago," when in reality it has been a couple of years.

Logging maintenance can be as simple as keeping a notebook where you write down the maintenance performed and what was used, including oil weights and part numbers. Or for an easier alternative, check out Toro's myTurf® Pro fleet management system. This web-based system can be used to track equipment hours automatically, order parts, schedule service and more — saving a lot of time compared to tracking these things manually using spreadsheets, binders or whiteboards.

5. Don't forget to do a functional premaintenance safety check.

Before you perform any maintenance tasks, make sure all the safety items are working properly. For example, can you disengage the drives and lower the cutting unit? These "pre - flight" inspections can give you an indication if you have leaks

(such as bearings leaking grease) or help you identify and repair early failures before these issues become more costly problems.

6. Stick with original equipment manufacturer TORO GENUINE parts.

It may be tempting to grab a filter from the local auto parts store when you need one, but an off-the-shelf product may not have the same specifications as the OEM part. It may look and fit the same but still vary in specification (for example, if a hydraulic filter doesn't have the bypass valve specified in the OEM version).
